

India Implementation of Smart City projects in Bhubaneswar City

Egis has been awarded Programme Management Consultant (PgMC) for Area Based Development Projects for Bhubaneswar Smart City Limited.

Under Government of India's prestigious Smart City Mission, Bhubaneswar, the capital of the State of Odisha, is the First one among 20 cities shortlisted for development in the first round of implementation. With a vision of developing a Livable, Child-friendly, Eco-friendly and TOD based, Economic hub of the region, the city has proposed to implement several Area Based Development (ABD) Projects as part of Smart City Proposal (SCP).
