The signature took place on 9 October at the Grande Halle de la Villette (Paris) during the Electric Days, a three-day exhibition and forum dedicated to the discovery of the energy solutions of the future developed by all the business lines of the EDF group.

Through this agreement, EDF and Egis made a commitment to cooperate for two years to take advantage of international opportunities in thermal engineering, energy transmission, heating networks, hydroelectricity and smart cities, in ten countries around the world.
